

Open Letter to The Washington Post

Dear Mr. Graham:

The Washington Post's vicious anti-Israel bias appeared again in "Israel Hems in a Sacred City, Encircling of Jerusalem Complicates Prospects for Peace," 2-10-04. Positioned on a full 1/3 of the front page, above the fold, dead center, with two full interior pages, a total of six color photos and three maps, the article baldly and falsely asserts that Israel is involved in a land grab.

- Why does The Post downplay that the Security Fence is designed to keep out terrorists?
- Why does The Post downplay the death toll from terrorists or the even larger number of ruined lives that made building The Fence necessary?
- Why does The Post rank inconvenience to Palestinians above Israeli lives and security?
- Why does The Post fail to report an accurate history of Israel's defensive wars, its victimization by Palestinian terrorists and Palestinian rejection of Israel's offer of peace at Camp David in 2000?
