

Open Letter to The Washington Post from EyeOnThePost

Dear Mr. Graham:

Why does *The Washington Post* refuse to call Palestinians terrorists what they are – terrorists?

On March 12 bombs were set off in Madrid, and many people were killed. In the first two days alone The Post called the perpetrators “terrorists” at least 15 different times over six different articles. That was accurate reporting. They were terrorists.

On March 14, while the bodies of the Spanish victims were still warm, two terrorists killed 11 Israelis in Ashdod, Israel. *The Washington Post* called the perpetrators “bombers,” “attackers,” “Palestinians,” and even, tenderly, “18-year-old Palestinian schoolmates,” but not “terrorists.” Half-truths are lies. They were terrorists.
